An impressive audience – more than 1200 participants – were part of presentations on the cutting-edge techniques, and on ideas and research that are guiding the Digital Field of Oral Health toward the future. They highly acknowledged the uniqueness of the event.

A pre-congress on Sunday afternoon preceded a densely loaded Scientific Program on Monday and Tuesday with clinically relevant lectures on surgical guides, framework design, digital workflows etc. and with hands-on exercises. The scientific program presented in a class of it's own. To personally meet Prof. Yimin Zhao with the application of his autonomous dental implant robot, perfectly sparked the two days of scientific exchange. He was followed by



Becoming a member of IADDM will give you the chance of exposure to innovations and cutting edge technologies related to digital dental medicine. There are four categories of membership:

Active Membership

Associate Membership

Any individual concerned with digital dental medicine is eligible for Associate Membership. Examples of individuals eligible for Associate Membership are physicians, dentists, dental technicians, other health care professionals and researchers.

Corporate or Association Membership

Manufacturers of medical/dental materials, equipment and instrumentation, publishing companies, other commercial organizations and associations with a special interest in the objectives of IADDM as judged by the Executive Committee of the IADDM and ratified by the General Assembly.

Student Membership

Students in undergraduate-postgraduate programs (e.g. MD, DMD or DDS) can become a post-graduate Student Member.

Honorary Membership

Honorary Membership will be limited to individuals identified by the Executive Committee of IADDM and ratified by the General Assembly as having made an exceptional contribution to digital dental medicine.
